



BEK Scholarship Opportunities

Soon high school seniors will be applying for college and making financial arrangements that will allow them to attend the college of their choice. Guidance Counselors will encourage students to apply for scholarships whenever they can. BEK Communications Cooperative is proud to offer several scholarship opportunities.

As in other years, high school seniors interested in applying for BEK scholarships will be given the opportunity to choose from several types of applications:

BEK Academic Scholarship

- Up to three \$500 Academic Scholarships will be awarded to students enrolled in an accredited college or university working towards a bachelor's degree. Applications will be judged on grades, appearance of application, school activities, volunteer work, work experience, home activities and creativity.

BEK Vocational / Technical Scholarship

- Up to three \$500 Vocational / Technical Scholarships will be awarded to students enrolled in an accredited vocational, technical or trade college working towards a program certificate, diploma or associate degree. The applications will be judged on grades, appearance of application, school activities, volunteer work, work experience, home activities and creativity.

BEK Broadcasting Scholarship

- Up to three \$500 Broadcasting Scholarships will be awarded to students who have completed training in BEK's broadcasting program and participated in at least one live event. Students being considered must be enrolled in an accredited college or university, vocational, technical or trade college working towards a program certificate, diploma or associate degree. The applications will be judged on grades, appearance of application, school activities, volunteer work, work experience, home activities, creativity and BEK Broadcasting participation.

It's easy to obtain one of these scholarship applications:

1. Contact your local high school counselor. Applications will be mailed to the schools by late November.
2. Download your application online from BEK's website at: www.bektel.com/scholarships.
3. Call or stop in the BEK office to request a scholarship application. Our toll free number is 1-888-475-2361.

These three BEK Scholarship applications must be postmarked by **March 12, 2015**.

BEK Technology Scholarship (Valley City State University)

- Specific to students currently attending or planning to attend Valley City State University, the BEK Technology Scholarship is awarded in the amount of \$2,500 for an entire academic year. To be considered, students must demonstrate a financial need, student or student parent must be a BEK customer or member, and the student must be enrolled in a program of technology study leading to an Associate or Bachelor degree. Examples of these majors include Software Engineering, Technology Education, and Computer Information Systems to name a few. Recommendations will be made to the BEK Board of Directors by the Valley City State University nominating committee, Financial Aid office, and Enrollment Services staff. Please note: the deadline for this scholarship is **February 15!**

Additional Scholarships Available

Foundation of Rural Services (FRS) and BEK Communications.

The FRS was established in 1994, in cooperation with the NTCA, which is the Rural Broadband Association. In keeping with its mission to sustain and enhance the quality of life throughout Rural America by advancing an understanding of rural telecommunications issues, the FRS is offering scholarships to further the education of rural youth.

About the FRS Scholarships:

There are 30 national FRS scholarships available. Should a student from the BEK Communications service area be selected, BEK will contribute an additional \$500 to the scholarship, for a total one-time scholarship award of \$2,500. It should be noted that preference will be given to individuals expressing an interest in returning to a rural area to work following graduation.

Students may also be eligible for four FRS Staurulakis Family Scholarships valued at \$5,000 each or two TMS Scholarships for \$1,500 each. Students who are majoring in math, science, engineering, or medicine are given preference for the FRS Staurulakis Family Scholarships.

Applications are available from your guidance counselor or can be downloaded from the FRS web site at <http://www.frs.org>. Completed applications should be sent directly to FRS, postmarked no later than **March 2, 2015**. Applications postmarked after March 2nd will not be accepted.
